

STATE ROAD (SR) 710 PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENVIRONMENT (PD&E) STUDY

SWC (Sandra Walters Consultants, Inc.) is part of the consultant team conducting a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 4 PD&E study for a 27-mile corridor of SR 710 (Beeline Highway) through Palm Beach and Martin counties. The project is anticipated to widen the roadways and reduce congestion as well as to enhance mobility, safety, emergency access and truck movement.

SWC's responsibilities include:

- ❖ field data collection for wetlands and threatened and endangered species along the project corridor,
- ❖ research of potential contamination sites along the project corridor including literature review utilizing Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and County databases and assessing the level of risk for contamination,
- ❖ groundtruthing of site locations and graphic representation of potential contamination sites utilizing the latest ArcGIS software,
- ❖ documentation of land use patterns in the area in regard to potential for secondary and cumulative impacts,
- ❖ participation in project progress meetings.
